At the International level there are four officers, 14 trustees and the Executive Director. There are three Districts at the International level; Americas, Asia/Pacific and European. In these three International Districts there are 50 Districts; 32 in the Americas, seven in Asia/Pacific and 11 in Europe. Our WI-UM District is one of the 32 Districts in the Americas and is comprised of six regions broken down into 22 Divisions which contain a total of 180 Clubs and over 5,600 individual members. Our WI-UM Board is comprised of three officers, six trustees and our District Executive Director. Our current District Governor is Lyle Plagenz, our Governor Elect is Fred Dietz and our Immediate Past Governor is Kathy Vorpahl.
