### MONDAY MORNING

We had 16 members at Monday's Road Trip to the Alliant Energy Wind Farm just east of Eden. We began the tour by hiking up to the closest wind tower at the Administration Building. Spread over 12.2 square miles (7,800 acres) the Cedar Ridge site offers a high capacity factor, which means there is adequate wind to regularly produce electricity. The 41 turbines produce approximately 68 megawatts of emissions-free energy – enough to power about 17,000 homes a year. The Administration Building at Cedar Ridge is Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certified. In addition to housing the day-to-day operations at Cedar Ridge, this building also houses an education center where school groups or community groups can come tour the facility, learn about wind energy and what they can do to make smart energy choices in the years to come.

### SERVICE PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

The Community Services Committee is working on two service project opportunities. The Salvation Army is looking for a Bell Ringer on August 21st at the Galloway House from 10:00AM – Noon. The second opportunity is also with the Salvation Army to put together backpacks for their Back to School Project. They're looking for 15 volunteers for August 24<sup>th</sup> from 10:00AM - 3:00PM.
