Matt Immel Treasurer of the Fair Board was our speaker. The fair has been around since 1852. It is a free fair except for parking and the grandstand shows. The attendance is around 50,000 people. It starts Tuesday and runs thru Sunday. When the weather turns hot, they have the Expo Center and Recreation center that are air conditioned. This year, they will have a birthing center in the Recreation Center. On Tuesday they will have fireplace works. It ends with Demolition Derby on Sunday. They get about 4,300 entries for judging with over \$200,000 raised from the sale of livestock. The board has nine members and last year showed a \$75,000 profit.
