FIRE EDUCATION, FIRE ALARMS, CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS AND FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Jason was here to explain how we need to educate students on fire prevention. The new plan is to have a plan to get out of your house as quickly as possible. It only takes four minutes to fully engulf a house. Younger students will get a height chart with rules to post at their house. Every time they post their height. They can review the fire rules. The next grades will get a fire prevention comic book with the rules. Families need to escape their homes faster before the fire engulfs their house. Kay is working with foster homes to equip them with smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers. All foster home to comply in order to take foster children. The Red Cross is helping with smoke detectors. We gave Kay \$500 to help with her program. We also gave Jason \$1,000 to help educate the students of Fond du Lac.
