<u>JOAN PINCH</u> RAMADA HOTEL

Joan Pinch, Noon Kiwanian, has been the Ramada's Director of Sales & Marketing for the past 12 years and prior to that she was involved in sales at an Oshkosh hotel for thirteen years, so she's been doing this for the past 25 years. The Ramada Plaza Hotel (originally named the Retlaw Hotel and listed in the National Register on September 7, 1984), has been a prominent commercial and visual downtown landmark since it was constructed in 1922. Milwaukee businessman Walter Schroeder (Retlaw is Walter spelled backwards) was responsible for the hotel construction. The Schroeder Hotel Company chain was one of the largest hotel chains in Wisconsin in the 1920s. The eight-story, 265-room hotel was opened in 1923. From 1923 through the 1970s, the hotel maintained its position as Fond du Lac's premier hotel. Such notable figures as John F. Kennedy, Hubert Humphrey, Eleanor Roosevelt, and leading Wisconsin politicians were known to have visited the hotel. Through a number of different remodelings, the current hotel has a room capacity of 132 rooms with 12 suites.
