Kate and Tom Groeschl are beekeepers and members of the Association. Since they retired two years ago, they turned their five-acre estate into a big hive. Three of the different bees are drones, worker bees and the queen. The Queen can lay up to 1500 eggs a day. Usually in May the hive split up and divide into a new hive. When the hive swarms, they capture them and form a new hive. Depending on the number of swarms, they can form new hives or sell to other beekeepers. The biggest enemy of the hives are mites.
